Key Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Approved full-time course
- 2. Lived 3 out of the last 5 years in Ireland, the EU, the EEA or Switzerland
- 3. Income level-all income level for 2019 (January 1^{st} December 31^{st}).

Points to note:

If you are eligible, you must create an account.

- If you are applying to SUSI, you must tick the SUSI option on your CAO Form so the CAO can inform SUSI of a college place offer.
- Priority is given to those students who apply before the closing dates and return all their requested documents on time.
- Applications open 23rd April (extended due to COVID-19)
- New Applications Closing: July (exact date unknown).
- There are 4 steps in Making an Application:
- 1. Fill out online application
- 2. Supply supporting documentation
- 3. Receive your grant decision
- 4. Receive your payment. The maintenance grant will be paid directly into your bank account in 9 monthly instalments. The Student Contribution Fee will be paid directly to your college.
